
Bright Lights & Merry Nights Holiday Lights Map

Free COVID-19 testing available

Free COVID-19 testing is available at the city gym in New Smyrna Beach located at 1000 Live Oak St. The test site offers self-swab rapid antigen and PCR testing and is open from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. daily. Results for rapid testing are expected within 15 minutes. There is no age requirement and symptoms are not required for testing. The site will close Dec. 24 and Dec. 25 for the Christmas holiday, and Jan. 1 for New Year's Day. For more information, visit www.volusia.org/testing.
