1. **Call to Order**

Ms. Remark, Chair, called the meeting to order at 6:31 p.m.

2. **Roll Call**

Roll was called with members present as listed above.

3. **Approval of Minutes:** October 17, 2023

4. **Discussion Item A: Jackie Robinson NHL**

Ms. Remark asked if the topic of what should be covered in the theme studies should be opened for discussion. Ms. Remark stated there is a lot of information about Jackie Robinson as well as Jackie Robinson ballpark.

Ms. Honse advised that the board would have to wait to hear back from the national park service. Ms. Honse stated the National Park Service does the actual study the Board would have to do the research and that would depend upon guidance from the National Park Service. Ms. Honse further stated the scope of the research should be kept on the national impacts rather than the local impacts.

Discussion Item B: Historic District Signage Maps

Mr. Gutierrez stated he had communicated with Mr. Dave Waller and the Board would need to decide which signs they wanted once the Board had a quorum.

5. **Other Business:**

Mr. Doug Gutierrez advised representatives for the Joe Petrali Foundation have contacted the city with the purpose of possibly making a memorial to Joe Petrali in Daytona Beach. The Foundation stated they would cover the costs of the memorial. They would like the city to donate about 700 square feet space for it.

In 1937 “Smoking” Joe Petrali set the first land speed record for motorcycles on the beach. That record was not broken till the motorcycle race moved from the beach to the Bonneville Salt Flats.

Mr. Makowski asked how many vacancies were currently on the Historic Preservation Board.
