WATER METER REPLACEMENT PROGRAM


The City of Daytona Beach is upgrading approximately 15,000 residential water meters with new, advanced technology that ensures more accurate readings. Because older meters may have under-reported usage, some customers might see an increase in their bill as the new meters reflect actual consumption. For billing questions, call (386) 671-8100.

What to Expect:

- Work will occur Monday through Friday, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Affected customers will receive at least 72 hours' notice before their meter is replaced.
- Installers will not need to enter your home.
- Water service will be briefly interrupted for 30 to 60 minutes during installation.
- Once the new meter is installed, service will resume as usual.
