Project Status: Under Construction

Restoration work at Sickler Park has begun, following damage from Hurricane Milton. Crews will rebuild the 102-foot concrete seat wall, restore nearby parking spaces and enhance the surrounding area with new grading, sod and erosion protection. The project also includes installing new structural supports and a handrail along the seawall to improve safety and accessibility.

The park will be temporarily closed during construction, and the city appreciates the public's patience as work progresses.
