SUBJECT: **2017 Enforcement Profiling Complaints/Racial Bias Complaints**

DATE: February 15, 2018

Per Departmental Standards Directive 1230.15 and Accreditation Standard 2.06M, the yearly statistics for Enforcement Profiling Complaints have been compiled. The Office of Professional Standards received three (3) complaints of racial profiling/racial bias in the 2017 calendar year. The complaints were reviewed by the Office of Professional Standards and it was determined that in two (2) of the complaints, both resulted in No Basis for Complaint as no policy violations occurred. The third complaint (CC2017-013) is currently open and after review, is determined to be No Basis for Complaint concerning this memo, but is being investigated at shift level as other potential policy violations exist.

In addition, the Office of Professional Standards conducted an annual review of agency practices involving bias based profiling which included the areas of forfeitures, traffic stops and seizures. No deficiencies noted during this review.
