Mission Statement

Office of Professional Standards

Purpose

The Office of Professional Standards (OPS) is charged with preserving the integrity of the Daytona Beach Police Department (DBPD). Organizationally, OPS is part of the Office of the Chief and serves at the discretion and authority of Chief Capri.

Tasks

The detectives assigned to OPS carryout many functions that ensure DBPD operates as a professional and transparent law enforcement agency. One of the tasks undertaken is the monthly and yearly review and analysis of all uses of force occurring Department wide.

The Office of Professional Standards and the Training Division work together to identify training deficiencies to ensure proper early intervention and to also identify possibilities of excessive force. Together we also ensure that Departmental Standards Directives and State Law were followed. In instances where policies may not be followed in whole, training initiatives are instituted to get the officers back on track and in compliance with directives. The following attached documentation breaks down all types of force used in the year 2018 by officers of the Daytona Beach Police Department.

Analysis

The 2018 Use of Force report was analyzed and showed an 18% reduction in use of force

incidents by departmental personnel, compared to 2017 use of force incidents. A total of 73 incidents was reported in 2018 (89 incidents in 2017).

This analysis revealed that more uses of force occurred in District One with 27 Use of Forces (37%) and District Two with 25 (34%) and 21 Use of Forces not identified by a district.

Charlie Platoon, for both districts had a combined total of the most Use of Force incidents by Shift with 16 (22%), followed by Alpha Platoon with 12, Delta Platoon with 10, and Bravo Platoon with 8. The remaining 27 incidents were completed by a unit or not identified with a Shift/Unit.

This analysis also revealed that, 74 Use of Force incidents occurred with Involved Citizens (60 on males and 14 on females). See Chart for Citizen Demographics.

A total of 16 female officers, 114 male officers, and 2 officer's sex unspecified, contributed to the Use of Force incidents. Officer's demographics can be provided upon request. See the attached reports for the number of Involved Officer incidents per officer and the list of Types of Force used by each officer during 2018.

There were no problem areas identified that required a change of policy, though some incidents were associated with officers being disciplined and retrained in techniques/tactics to include de-escalation and weapons transition. There are no recommendations at this time. The Daytona Beach Police Department is now a participant in the National Use of Force Data Collection database by the U.S. Department of Justice and Federal Bureau of Investigation.
