

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-212

AN ORDINANCE CREATING SECTION 14-21 OF THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES TO PROHIBIT THE FEEDING OF PIGEONS WHEN SUCH FEEDING CREATES A PUBLIC NUISANCE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT.

WHEREAS, an amendment has been prepared to City Code Chapter 14, relating to Animal Control, to prohibit the feeding of pigeons when such feeding creates a public nuisance; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police recommends approval of the amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF DAYTONA BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. Chapter 14, City Code, is hereby amended to create Section 14-21 as follows [underline indicates added text]:

CHAPTER 14 – ANIMALS

* * * [*omitted text not affected by this ordinance*]

Sec. 14-21. Prohibition on feeding of pigeons so as to create a public nuisance.

(a) Prohibition. No person shall feed, or in any manner provide food for, one or more pigeons in such a manner as to result in a public nuisance.

(b) Definition. A public nuisance in the context of this section shall include the accumulation of droppings and/or feathers, the attraction of vermin, the blockage of streets or public rights-of-way, or the causing of damage to real property.


SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
