- Poster shall be drawn on an 8 ½" x 11" white paper. It could be drawn vertically or horizontally.
- Please attach to the back of the poster the student's name, grade, school name, teacher's name. Entry forms are provided, or the information can be written clearly on the back of the poster.
- Each poster must portray a Water Conservation Idea in a slogan, drawing, or both. Students may use crayons, paint, color pencils, or markers. No highlighters, photos, or computer graphics are permitted.
- Students must work on posters individually, otherwise posters will be disqualified.
- Only original artwork will be accepted (no trade-marked or copyrighted materials).
